DIOCESAN MISSION CO-OPERATIVE PLAN

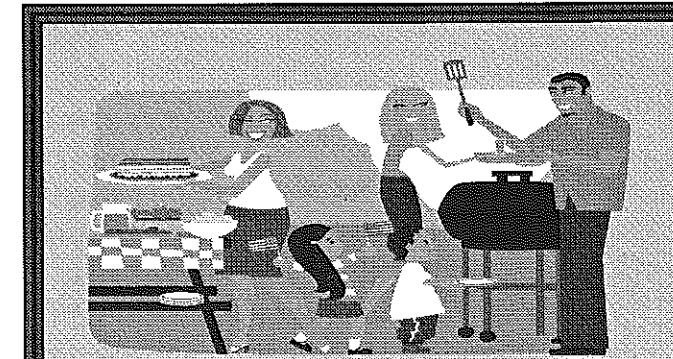
