FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK: "A CATHOLIC FUNERAL"

Did you know that it is our tradition to celebrate the Funeral Liturgy for Catholics in the church? It is our custom to celebrate the Funeral Mass in the church with the body present. When it is not possible to have the body present, the cremated remains may be brought to the church. Sometimes family members who are not Catholic or who have abandoned the practice of their faith feel uncomfortable celebrating a Funeral Mass in the church on behalf of the deceased. In such circumstances it may be appropriate to celebrate a Liturgy of the Word (without Communion) in the church. A funeral liturgy for a member of our church at a local funeral home is strongly discouraged. It is important that you (as a practising Catholic) make this information, as well as your personal wishes, known to your family members and those who will be responsible for making your funeral arrangements. It is also recommended that you include these wishes in your will. (Liturgy Office: Diocese of Hamilton)
