FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK: "WELCOME BISHOP DOUGLAS CROSBY"

With great joy we offer prayers and welcome to our new Diocesan Bishop, Bishop Douglas Crosby, OMI. Bishop Crosby was born in Marathon, Ontario June 28, 1949 the eldest of seven children. He was ordained as an Oblate Priest September 27, 1975. Bishop Crosby was assigned as assistant pastor at the Co-Cathedral of Our Lady of Perpetual Help, Labrador City and later served as vocation director, coordinator of provincial services; pastor of St. Joseph Parish, Ottawa and then Provincial Superior of the Oblates of Mary Immaculate. He also served as Director of the CCCB Missions Office and English-language General Secretary of the CCCB. He was appointed bishop November 4, 1997 and ordained a bishop at St. Joseph, Ottawa January 2nd, 1998 and installed as the Bishop of Labrador. In 2003 he was appointed Bishop of St. George's, Corner Brook, Newfoundland and Labrador. On September 24, 2010 he was appointed Bishop of Hamilton Diocese and will be installed November 8, 2010. His motto is "Trahe Nos" (Draw Us) a fervent prayer in response to Jesus' declaration in John 6:44. "No one can come to me unless drawn by the Father who sent me!"
