FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK: SOCIETY OF JESUS "THE JESUITS" - 400 YEARS OF SERVICE

This year marks the 400th anniversary of the Jesuits coming to bring the Gospel to Canada. Over the decades they fulfilled their mission as evangelists, explorers, cartographers, educators, chroniclers and pastors. More than any other religious order, the Jesuits not only witnessed the birth of Canada, but they shaped significant parts of its history. The Canadian Martyrs remind us of the great sacrifices that were made in bringing the Gospel to Canada. The Jesuits have a long history in Guelph and served this parish from 1852 until 1931. They established their Canadian headquarters in Guelph in 1913. The Loyola House Retreat Centre welcomes people from all parts of the world to pray the spiritual exercises of their founder St. Ignatius of Loyola. The Spiritual Exercises becomes a means of knowing, experiencing, understanding and growing in intimacy with Jesus Christ.
