**FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK: "SAFE  
INTERNET USE TIPS FOR PARENTS"**

*\* take time to become educated about the  
Internet; it's an investment in the safety and  
health of your children*

*\* select an Internet Service Provider with a  
Filter Access*

*\* tell your children not to respond to any  
belligerent or suggestive contact or to  
anything that makes them feel uncomfortable  
and to let you know if anything like this  
happens*

*\* do not permit face to face meetings with  
people they meet on the Internet, unless there  
is a good reason to do so and you or someone  
you trust is present*

*\* do not overreact if your children bring  
something inappropriate to your attention or  
they will be intimidated and will not do so  
again*

*\* do not miss the significance of hidden disks  
– usage of pornographic or hate-filled  
materials tend to be secretive*

*\* remind your children that these rules apply  
whenever they use computers at locations  
outside the home, such as libraries*

*\* above all communicate! The best protection  
is good relationships with a healthy Christian  
family life in which family members talk and  
pray together.*
